This Kit contains everything needed to initiate evidence collection at any incident scene including:

- Evidence Collection Guide,
- Pen/pencils,
- Measuring tape,
- Evidence bags,
- Identification tags, and
- Barrier tape.

*A camera is an invaluable investigation tool; however, as the majority of investigators now have access to cell phones with camera capability, a one-time use camera is NOT contained in the Basic Kit. If you require cameras with your kits:

- Obtain them locally and include them in your Kit, or

Kit Contents

Evidence Collection Guide

This is the heart of the Investigation Kit and it guides investigators in a systematic way to ensure no evidence is overlooked. It allows you to document:

- Notifications & Response Times
- Incident Scene Sketches & Measurements
- Physical Evidence & Photograph Log
- Identity, Contact Details & Witness's First Observations



Witness Note Pages

Use these to capture witness's first thoughts. Witnesses can jot down their observations in point form and draw a sketch on the back of the page. They should keep these as their notes until you have time for a formal interview.

Camera Use a camera to tell the story. Use the Photo Log in the Guide to record details of each photo as memories fade in time. Why was this photo taken? What is it depicting?



*NOTE: A one-time use camera is NOT included in the basic Kit.

Fluorescent Barricade Tape (150 feet)

Get your investigation off to a sound start by taping off the area to secure it. Protect the scene and the evidence it contains, and at the same time protect others who might wander into the area to see what happened.



Evidence Bags & Tags

Use the plastic bags and paper tags to store and label physical evidence. A knife is also included to cut evidence free or take paint scrapings etc. The Guide also contains a place to record a description of each piece of evidence as well as where it was found and where it is stored now. Pens and pencils are also included.



Examination Gloves

Use these light duty gloves when dealing with harmful substances such as human blood. Band-Aids and antiseptic wipes are included just in case.

Tape Measure (33 feet)

Pacing off or estimating distances is simply not acceptable! You need to know exact distances. The Guide contains a page to draw a sketch and record your measurements of where you found debris, tools, clothing and personnel evidence. Use the chalk to mark the location of evidence prior to measurement
